She is the 3rd state champion in school history (Chad Misco and Joe Samsa). -Girl's Basketball team –Conference Champs, Regional Champs, and Sectional Champs. -Girl's Basketball State Tournament

-Girls play at state on Friday, 02/8/2024, at approximately at 10:45 am at the Resch Center in Green Bay.

-There is a contest between the 4 schools in each division to see who sells the most tickets, with the winner getting \$2,000 for their school.
