

## **SUMMER SCHOOL 2024**

This is your invitation to participate in our summer school program.



We have some changes to our program this year.

- The program will run only 3 weeks this year. June 10-13, 17-20 & 24-27
- It will still be Monday –Thursday, 8:30-11:30 am
- We can only offer one swimming lessons session the first 2 weeks. It will be the same times and routine. Students will be bussed to and from the Bond Center, getting back around 1:20.

We have a different concept this year because of some new and exciting classes.

- We still have the 3 periods of the day,
- Bowling will take up 2 class periods for an entire week and
- Rhubarb and Berry classes will take up all 3 periods for an entire week.



- You will sign up for classes for week 1, week 2 and week 3
- Even if your child signs up for the single hour classes- cooking, art, music, outdoor activities, academics or basketball skills, it will still be for one week.
- You can sign up for a class more than once.

You will need to fill out the forms for each week.



# Summer School Classes Descriptions

All classes will run on 1 week intervals. You may sign up for a class more than one week.

### Elementary Skill Builder / K-4th

Students will have a guided review to reinforce and build on the topics and concepts covered during the school year.

Cooking / I week intervals/ See the age groups per period on the sign up sheet

An all-time favorite. Cooking is a hands on class where students prepare and make easy snacks and foods.

### Whimsay Wall Installations 1 week intervals/ K-8<sup>th/</sup> Various age groups

Students will be engaged with working on a collaborative project/piece to create wall hangings that are colorful but expressive. Each student will be part of the process to develop a piece of fabric. Once all the pieces are developed, the final step is to stitch all the pieces together to make a collaborative work.



### Wonderful World of Rhubarb / 1 week / All 3 hours of the day/ 4th and up

Students will attend this class for one week and all 3 hours of the day. They will learn about rhubarb and make various recipes using rhubarb and learn how to use and preserve rhubarb.

Berry Bonanza/ 1 week intervals/ 2 weeks offered/ all 3 hours of the day/ 4<sup>th</sup> and up

Students will attend this class for one week and all 3 hours of the day. They will travel to a berry farm to pick strawberries; will make various recipes using strawberries and make strawberry preserves.



Bowling/ 1 week intervals/ Periods 1 & 2/ Separate Fee \$10.00/week/ all ages

Students will ride vans driven by school staff to the Lena Bowling Lanes where they will be able to bowl 2 games. They will return to school before the 3<sup>rd</sup> period begins.



Music/ 1 week intervals/ See the age groups per period on the sign up sheet

Students will explore and play age appropriate musical instruments.



### Outdoor Activities / 1 week intervals / Any age

Students will experience the outdoors through a variety of activities. These may include working as a team to build survival shelters, creating things from natural materials, seeking out wildlife, and learning a few survival skills. Get outside at school this summer!



### Sports History & Cards/1 week intervals/2<sup>nd</sup> and Up

Learn about the history of different sports and the stars and legends who played them. Browse and investigate sports cards. Do you have one worth millions?



### Family History Dig/1 week intervals/ 3rd & up

Curious about where your ancestors come from? Do you have a famous person in your family tree? Maybe you can find out. We will do some digging into family histories. Is that your great great Grandpa Joe on that poster?

The cost of bowling per student is \$10.00 per week




